

Extra Credit for REVIT Spring 2009 – Total 20pts IDLCPA Support

What is IDLCPA?

The Interior Design Legislative Coalition of Pennsylvania (IDLCPA) is a not-forprofit organization committed to advancing the interior design profession through licensing and regulation.

IDLCPA has over 750 members consisting of interior design professionals, students, educators, industry partners, and affiliated professionals. The board has 26 appointed members serving from locations across Pennsylvania.

The bill now has a number, HB 1521, and needs to move quickly through the House. The bill does not take away a person's right to call themselves an interior designer, it allows those with the proper education, experience, and certification to be licensed with the state of PA as a "Registered Interior Designer" and therefore is in compliance with the IBC 2006 that "only a registered design professional" may implement the code. With your support this can happen!

Extra Credit:

15 Pts:

To earn extra credit you must write a letter, email, or call your legislator. Visit <http://www.house.state.pa.us> to find your legislator. To receive credit you must provide me with proof that you contacted your legislator i.e. email response from your representative's office or the name, position, date and time of the person you spoke with at their office.

You will receive 5 points for contacting your legislator. You can also receive 10 more points by having 2 other people contact their PA legislators as well (5 pts for each person). They can be friends, family, co-workers as long as they are registered to vote in PA.

5pts:

You can also receive an extra 5 pts by writing a short letter of support (about a paragraph) that will be posted on IDLCPA's website. The letter should state why interior design legislation is important to you as a student.

You can do all of the extra credit or just one part. If you are not registered to vote in PA let me know and we can make other arrangements for you to earn extra credit.
